POSITION SUMMARY:

Provide gymnastics instruction to participants of different ages and ensure that they thrive and are successful within the program. In addition, this position supports the work of the Y, a leading nonprofit, charitable organization committed to strengthening community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Monitor gymnastics activities of all participants, intervening to correct technique where necessary.
2. Instruct gymnastics classes in a safe, enjoyable, positive environment.
3. Constructs and implements weekly/monthly educational lesson plans.
4. A genuine desire for working with children and helping them succeed.
5. Observe and spot athletes as they perform on various apparatus.
6. Create and maintain positive relationships with participants, aiming to encourage them in a positive attitude.
7. Maintain facility cleanliness, includes bathrooms, sitting area, and equipment.
8. Attends meetings pertinent to position.
9. Other duties as assigned by supervisor.
